What's Next?

If you've haven't done so yet, ***the next step in our process is for you to officially accept your son's enrollment offer.***

Please follow up with the enrollment offer you received asap. From there, you will gain access to the actual application document.



We want to make the enrollment process as easy and streamlined as possible. Our families are expected to complete their applications within 2 weeks. This allows us to keep up with the number of students who will be attending SABA this fall. If you are unable to complete the application in your 2 week time frame, please reach out to me directly and stay in communication so that we know you are working on it. If you are having difficulty uploading any documents or filling out your forms, you can reach out for assistance.

Don't Delay!

As our enrollment list continues to grow in the coming days, it is likely that students for some grades will begin to be placed on waiting lists, if families have not accepted their son's enrollment. Students who land on our waiting list are not guaranteed admission to SABA.

Our slots are rapidly filling, so I encourage you to accept your son's enrollment offer as soon as possible. Particularly if you are concluding that a traditional school setting is not the ideal fit for your son, ***now there is another choice in our community at SABA.***

Commonly Asked Questions About SABA

Where exactly is SABA located?

SABA will be welcoming our Kings in grades 3-to-6 to our school in the heart of Pittsboro beginning August 14.

We're located a mile away from the downtown courthouse, just off the intersection of US 15-501 and NC-87.

This means SABA is easy to reach from all parts of Chatham and neighboring counties. If you live or work in communities such as Siler City, Sanford, Moncure, Fearrington, Chapel Hill, Carrboro, Apex or Saxapahaw, it's a short, simple drive from your home to ours!



Will SABA offer transportation?

Yes. Buses will pick up and drop off students at designated stops to and from the school campus. Bus stops will be centrally located and based on enrolled students' addresses.

Does it cost to attend SABA?

No! SABA is a North Carolina Public Charter School, so there is no cost for admission.

Will there be before & after school at SABA?

SABA is presently finalizing plans with local youth service provider organizations to offer before and/or after school care at SABA.

Will lunch be provided at SABA?

Yes. All students attending SABA will be provided lunch.

What are the different types of art forms that will be taught at SABA?

Visual Arts, Performing Arts (Theatre), Music, Dance and Technology will be introduced to all students at SABA.

Will SABA Kings have access to technology?

Yes. SABA will be a 1:1 school; meaning that every child will have a school issued device for academic use.
