Is it time to consider a different school for your son this fall?

Dear Chatham County Parent,

As your family transitions in to summer, you're probably taking some time to assess your son's experiences in the past school year.

Based on what I am hearing from many parents, the learning environment in 2022-23 left a lot to be desired. If you're a family that is reaching the conclusion that there must be a better way to educate your son, I am respectfully asking that you consider School of the Arts for Boys Academy in Pittsboro. **SABA is the only tuition-free NC Public Charter School serving boys exclusively. We will open our doors on August 14, serving boys in grades 3-to-6 and will add a new grade with each successive school year.**

This structure means that your son will be able to earn his high school diploma at SABA. You won't need to change schools again any time in the future.

As an experienced teacher and administrator in our local public schools, I have watched with concern as our young boys find it difficult to achieve their full potential in traditional school settings. Here in Chatham County and nationally there is a widely documented Achievement Gap that begins to become evident by around third grade. Perhaps you are sensing it in your student's learning experience.

In the past school year alone, we've seen incidents in our local schools that have drawn national attention for inappropriate student behavior. Last month 5 juveniles were arrested for making threats of violence toward one of our middle schools. It is more evident than ever before that we need to provide young people with a safe, structured environment for education.



Our Environment

This is why our group of area educators and community leaders is choosing to bring SABA to Chatham County. Our school is built specifically to meet the needs of young boys in our community. Our Kings will grow academically, mentally, physically and socially through a culturally responsive learning experience. Personalized Education Plans (PEP) will be developed for all students to individualize instruction. Teachers will differentiate the curriculum to meet specific learning needs for all students.

Your son will be known, appreciated, supported and encouraged at SABA.

Our Academics

As North Carolina's first charter school specifically licensed to educate boys, SABA takes a comprehensive approach to teaching our students. We will benchmark and monitor our boys' progress. Superior academic performance will be embraced and encouraged. Our Kings will learn to see themselves as future mathematicians, scientists, technologists, artists, business leaders and more.

SABA will follow the **NC Standard Course of Study** and will incorporate the **AVID Learning Method** to promote college readiness. The **Multiple Intelligences** teaching concept will enable us to focus on each student's specific learning style and to provide instruction that meets their needs and fosters an enthusiasm for learning and self-confidence.

SABA is recognized as an **A+ School by the North Carolina Arts Council**. Several research studies indicate that use of the arts in education is a significant way to close achievement gaps and increase graduation rates.

Our Location – Ideal For Busy Families

SABA is pleased to announce that our school is centrally located in the heart of Pittsboro, a mile away from the downtown courthouse. Our 1.9 acre campus is just off the intersection of US 15-501 and NC-87 and easy to reach from all parts of Chatham and neighboring counties.

Our school includes large classrooms and ample outdoor space to encourage play and outdoor studies.

SABA will also offer transportation and after school programs to enhance access to our school and serve families with busy schedules.

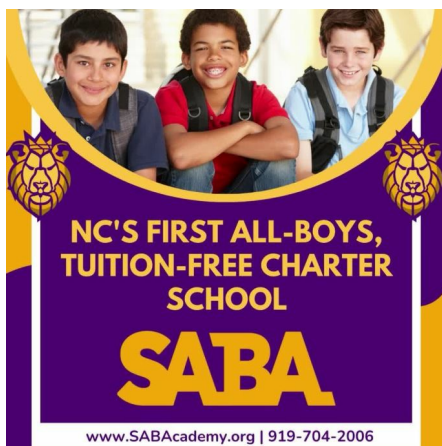
